

## Steps to Connect to Wireless

- 1> Switch Wireless ON, device laptop/smartphone/tablet..
- 2> Search for Wireless Networks (Laptop only) as other devices automatically search

View your basic network information and set up connections

Change your networking settings

- Set up a new connection or network
